**Citizens for Brentwood Greenspace appoint former City Commissioner Alex Noble to board**

The Citizens for Brentwood Greenspace have announced that former Brentwood City Commissioner Alex Noble was appointed to its board of directors at their recent annual meeting. He fills a vacancy created when long-time board member John Logan moved from Brentwood. Officers were also elected at the meeting with the following results: Gil Hutchinson, president; George Malo, vice-president; Bert Bosse, treasurer; and David Kumatz, secretary.

Noble is a native of the Brentwood area. His grandfather, Dr. Albert Noble, moved to the area in 1917 and built a drugstore at the corner of Franklin Road and Old Hickory Boulevard in 1929. His father, Glenn Noble, helped with the incorporation of the city in the late 1960s, having chaired the Chamber of Commerce committee that recommended incorporation. A retired highway engineer, Noble served five years as city commissioner, six years on the Planning Commission and currently serves on the Board of Zoning Appeals.

“Alex has been a driving force in creating an awareness of the importance environmental issues have in our community. He has a unique perspective and vision on what it takes for our community to continue to prosper without destroying the natural beauty that makes Brentwood such a desirable place to live, work and play. We’re honored to have Alex join our board,” said Hutchinson.

Our mission is to preserve open space in the form of parks, trails, historic sites, and flood plains while being sensitive to the rights of landowners and developers.
